The Paintings are never static as they are interacting with patterns and symbols as light falls on the surface of the painting. As the series develops the shapes are too, I started with two dimensions, now I am painting three dimensions and now using Gold leaf I feel there are more dimensions to explore. The light causes structure to appear and disappear. The viewer has the desire to fix the now into an organized pattern, but the light shifts constantly expressing the inevitability of change.

I completed a foundation Art course in Barking College 1997. In 2000 I graduated with a Fine Art degree in Painting at the Kent institute of and Design, there I received the 'David Haste Landscape AWARD for my final show in Painting. Then In 2002 I decided I wanted to teach Art and Painting so I did a Post Graduate PGCE in Art Education.

From 2006 to 2009 I worked at Science Ltd as Fabricator and Studio Assistant for the artist Damien Hirst and was promoted to the Assistant Manager/Manager from 2007-2009. From 2003 to 2012 I was a Tutor at the University of East London, and at Lewisham College in South London at the Pupil Referral Units 2003-2007 and 2009-2013 I worked in several London colleges teaching Art to students from disadvantaged backgrounds including challenging behavior and special educational needs.

I am currently teaching Painting privately online and one to one settings, I teach beginners to advanced Oil and Acrylic painting, mostly figurative, still life and Landscape as well as abstract painting. I also paint Murals for a local charity for mental health wellbeing. And I am a freelance artist at Pop Up Painting where I teach large groups of beginners by guiding them through famous paintings, demonstrating step by step many different techniques from Impressionism to Pop art.

I am continually working on Commissions of my own paintings and I have exhibited locally and internationally.

A selection of my paintings are currently in an online exhibition called Butterfly Effect and I am one of a group of artists who have been awarded the Faces of PEACE PRIZE by the Contemporary Art Curator Magazine.
